Class 1	Pairs. Kindly sponsored by Sandons Saddlery Open to any combination, no lead reins allowed. Pairs will be judged on style Height approx. 2'6"	Entry fee £24 per pair
Class 2	Restricted Novice. Kindly sponsored by Kemp Herbs Horse and rider combination not to have been placed 1st or 2nd in any hunter trial (excluding pairs) in the last 3 years. Height approx. 2'6"	Entry fee £15
Class 3	Novice. Kindly sponsored by Spring Farm Partnership Horse and rider together not to have won more than £30 in any hunter trial, horse trial or x-country event in the last 3 years (excluding pairs). Height approx. 2'6"	Entry fee £15
Class 4	Members of the NNH, NNHSC and NNPC. The Benjamin Bulwer Long Memorial Trophy for the highest paid up adult member of the NNH and the Charlotte Thompson Memorial Trophy for the highest placed member of the NNPC. <i>Bottle of bubbly to the oldest placed member of the NNH.</i> Height approx. 2'6"	Entry fee £15
Class 5	Intermediate. Kindly sponsored by Westover Vets Height approx. 2'9"	Entry fee £15

COMPETITORS NOTES – PLEASE READ

Guidelines from The Pony Club – Based on BEF / British Eventing guidelines agreed with the Government for Resumption of Sport – behind closed doors (no spectators) Please only compete if you can comply - this is the only way we can run the competition and we may well be subject to external scrutiny, so please follow all directions and maintain 2m distance. We need to manage the risk to all on site: competitors, supporters, volunteers and our local community. All guidelines are subject to change at short notice.

- **Pre entries only – no one suffering COVID 19 symptoms or in lockdown area / restrictions as per www.gov.uk to attend. Closing date 27 October, times will be published by Friday 30 October on North Norfolk Harriers and North Norfolk Pony Club Facebook, NNH email and WhatsApp groups.**
- **Please print your own numbers, at clear quality and at 100% scale and provide your own number bib, there will be no number bibs or numbers provided**
- **3 numbers are needed per horse: 2 for number bib and one for vehicle windscreen, please place one of your numbers in the windscreen of your vehicle for access to the site**
- **Please park where directed, leaving 5 – 10m between lorries, and please no large lorry ramp parties, maintain social distancing.**
- **No Spectators or additional non competing children**
- **One rider and one additional supporting person only, except for Under 18 where two parents/guardians are allowed if absolutely necessary. The support person must travel in the vehicle to the event with the rider and ideally be able to drive the vehicle and horse home in the event of an accident. Supporting people must be available to help the rider alongside medical staff in the event of an accident if needed**
- **Results will be published by Monday 2 November on North Norfolk Harriers and North Norfolk Pony Club Facebook, NNH email and WhatsApp groups**
- **AT EVENT: Minimise time on site please to contain numbers and maintain 2m social distancing

NORTH NORFOLK HARRIERS HUNTER TRIAL CONDITIONS AND COVID COMPLIANCE INFORMATION

1. Entry is in advance only for all classes including Minimus, the closing date for entries will be 27 October 2020, times will be issued for all entries by Friday 30 October.
2. Entries will not be accepted without the appropriate fee. Entry fees will only be refunded if the event is cancelled due to weather and if we are unable to reschedule. Preferred method of payment is via BAC's
3. 2m social distancing & sanitisation procedures will be in operation.
4. Anyone vulnerable, displaying any COVID 19 symptoms, or from a lock-down area must not attend.
5. The organisers, officials, helpers and landowner cannot accept any liability for accidents, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
6. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or alter the course or any class if considered necessary.
7. 5. A skull cap or hat with safety harness according to EN1384 plus any of the following standards: ASTM F1163, PAS15, VG1.040, Snell E2001 or AS/NZS 3838 or higher must be worn by all competitors. No hats with fixed peaks. The organisers strongly recommend the wearing of back protectors. The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone present must themselves take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. Instructions given by any officials must be obeyed.
8. Medical armbands are compulsory for under 18's and are strongly recommended for all competitors
9. No recording devices permitted (eg hat and/or body cams, GoPro's etc).
10. Results will be published via email, WhatsApp and social media, the judges decision is final. Those who are placed will have there rosettes posted to the address provided
11. Horse or pony must be 4 years old or over.
12. It is the riders responsibility to be ready to start at your allocated time
13. The fence judges and other officials reserve the right to withdraw any horse or pony that, in their opinion, is not fit to compete.
14. This Hunter Trial will be run under Pony Club rules for Hunter Trials. Please also refer to the course map.
15. Dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times.
