The entrance is off the A148 Holt/Cromer Road turn off at the layby and enter the park through the West Gate which will be signposted – NOT CROMER HALL MAIN ENTRANCE OR HOME FARM ENTRANCE

- Clear Round:** Course will be small and is intended for novice riders and young horses/ponies and those on a lead rein to get going and have a go! Pairs allowed
Prizes: rosettes
Entry Fee £ 5.00 per horse/pony
- Class 1:** **Beginners:** Course will be the same course as the clear round but will include a timed section.
Prizes: rosettes to 8th place
Entry Fee £ 8.00
- Class 2:** **Open Pairs:** Course will be approximately 2'3" - 2'6" and will include a time section. Will be judged on style as a pair side by side.
Prizes: rosettes to 8th place
Entry Fee £16.00/Pair
- Class 3:** **Open Novice:** Course will be approximately 2'3" – 2'6" and will include a timed section.
Prizes: rosettes to 8th place & the WALKER CUP to the best under 14yr NNPC member.
Entry Fee £10.00
- Class 6:** **Intermediate:** Course will be approximately 2'9 - 3'0"
Prizes: rosettes to 8th place
Entry Fee £10.00
- Class 7:** **Open:** Course will be approximately 3'0" - 3'3" and will include a timed section.
Prizes: rosettes to 8th place & the ASSOCIATES CUP to the best 17yrs and over NNPC.
Entry Fee £10.00

DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES

The course will be open for inspection from 2pm on Friday 29 March 2019.

Entries close on Monday 25 March 2019. Entries will be accepted on the day but will be an extra £3 per class.

NORTH NORFOLK HARRIERS HUNTER TRIAL CONDITIONS

1. Entries will not be accepted without the appropriate fee. **Entry fees will only be refunded if the event is cancelled due to weather and if we are unable to reschedule.**
2. Entries close Monday 25 March 2019. Late entries will be accepted at £3 extra per class, space permitting.
3. The organisers, officials, helpers and landowner cannot accept any liability for accidents, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
4. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or alter the course or any class if considered necessary.
5. A skull cap or hat with safety harness according to EN1384 plus any of the following standards: ASTM F1163, PAS15, VG1.040, Snell E2001 or AS/NZS 3838 or higher must be worn by all competitors. The organisers strongly recommend the wearing of back protectors. The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone present must themselves take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. Instructions given by any officials must be obeyed.
6. No recording devices permitted on hats (eg hat cameras, GoPro's etc).
7. The judges' decision is final. Objections must be lodged, together with the sum of £25, with the secretary within 30 minutes of results being posted.
8. Horse or pony must be 4 years old or over.
9. Once a competitor has declared, it is his or her responsibility to be ready to start before the close of the class in question.
10. Please leave enough money to pay for postage if you are not likely to be able to accept any prizes won in person.
11. The fence judges and other officials reserve the right to withdraw any horse or pony that, in their opinion, is not fit to compete.
12. This Hunter Trial will be run under Pony Club rules for Hunter Trials. Please also refer to the course map.
13. All horses and ponies on site must be fully vaccinated for Equine Influenza under current guidelines. Passports may be checked.
14. Dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times.
